

The Major Sites

1 Former Site of Kushima Castle

The ruins of Kushima Castle, built by the first Lord of the Omura han, Yoshiaki Omura. The curvature of the stone walls is impressive.

2 Historic Omura Royal Port

Was used exclusively by Lord Omura to board his boats. The enclosure no longer stands.

3 Terashima

Naozumi Fujiwara, said to be the ancestor of the Omura line, first landed in the region here. It has been used as the location for historical television dramas.

4 Honkoji Buke Yashiki Street

This street runs to the Otomon Gate of Kushima Castle, and was the main street of the samurai residential area.

5 Gokokan Onari Mon

This was the entrance to Gokokan school. Any child, regardless of social class, could attend the school, but only the Omura family could use this gate.

6 Koshokoji Buke Yashiki Street

This street was occupied by the Lord's pages, known as 'Kosho', this giving it its name. Many of the stone walls still remain.

7 The Site of Hinatabira samurai residence

This old samurai residence marks the area where one of the "37 Samurai", chief Nakao, lived.

8 Former residence of Masataka Kusumoto

One of the "37 samurai" of Omura, Masataka Kusumoto worked to overthrow the Shogunate. His former residence is open to the public as an example of a Samurai residence.

9 Uwakoji Buke Yashiki Street

The longest Samurai residence (Buke Yashiki) street in Omura. Many of the stone walls still stand.

10 Garden of Former Enyuji Temple

This Kare-sansui (rock garden) is designed on a slope and is a valuable example of a garden incorporating rocks in the early Edo style.

11 Kusabakoji Buke Yashiki Street

This street is lined with beautiful walls, unique to the Omura region, decorated with multi-colored stones from the ocean and mounted with stucco. The Garden of former Enyuji Temple is closed to this street.

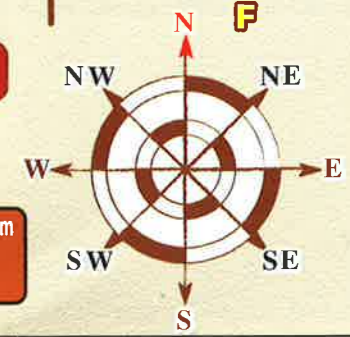
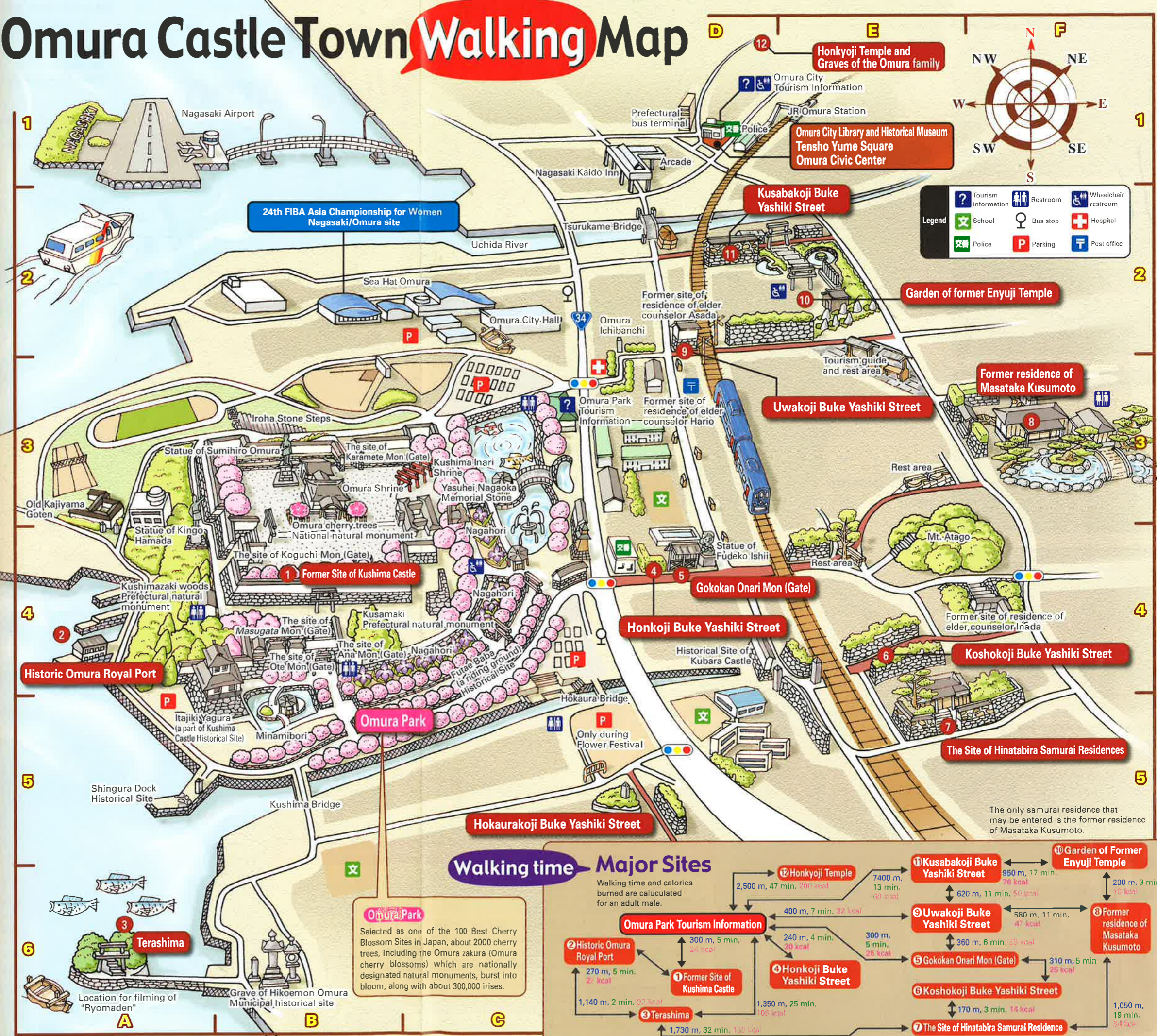
12 Honkyoji Temple and Graves of the Omura family

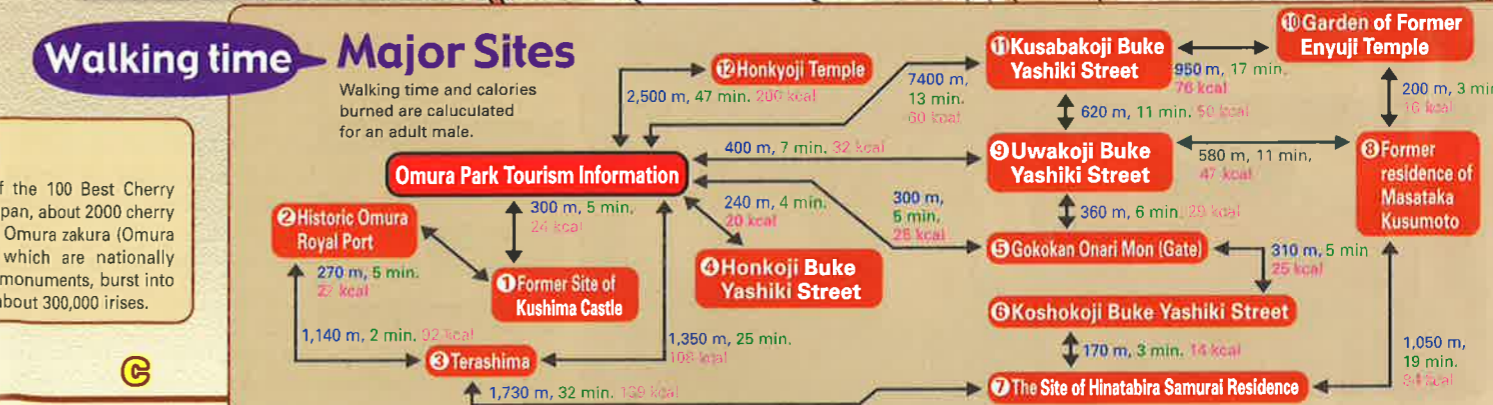
Omura Castle Town Walking Map
